PROGRAM OUTLINE:

The Manhattan Implant Institute program is limited to 15 clinicians. Our program will give the clinicians attending this course the confidence and ability to practice new and proven techniques and innovative approaches to a different number of surgical and reconstructive procedures that could be implemented with the right approach and confidence in the day-to-day operations of their own practice. Procedures like implant placement, bone graft procedure, immediate socket preservation after tooth extraction, bone and soft tissue regeneration, sinus lift techniques, immediate implant placement after tooth extraction and other surgical procedures.

Case presentations lectures will be held every morning before clinic that will focus on treatment planning, treatment and managing of patients and other full mouth reconstruction procedures, illustrating how these surgical techniques can be used and the final results on different types of cases.

At the end of the course, participants will receive a certificate of attendance along with a total number of 40 CE (Continuing Education) hours.
